MEMBERS NEEDED FOR 12TH STEP CALL LIST

If you are interested in helping new or "coming back" alcoholics get to their first meeting, consider placing your name on the 12th Step List.

More Calgary and area Alcoholics Anonymous members, ideally with one of more years of sobriety, are needed to let their name stand for the list, which serves Calgary and district communities, explains Buddy B., Telephone Monitoring Chair.

The 12th Step List is a list of the names and phone numbers of AA men and women, who are available to talk to those who are still struggling and want more information about the AA program.

The confidential list is used by those providing service as telephone monitors. If a monitor receives a call from someone still struggling with the disease, who is looking for more information about the AA program, the monitor can have someone on the 12th Step List give that individual a call.

While being a member of the 12th Step List requires a level of commitment from the AA member to help out as they can, it is also tailored to meet their specific availability.

Members applying to have their names on the list can indicate which quadrant of the city they are available in, or whether they are available city wide. They can also select the time of day when they are available whether it be mornings only, weekdays only, evenings only, weekends only, or anytime. And they also indicate whether they have a car available or not.

The 12th Step List also looking for AA members who can speak a wide range of languages including French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Spanish and many others.

The first role of the 12th Step member is to call the individual to understand their circumstance and answer questions about the AA program. That may lead to meeting with the individual to discuss the program in more detail, or helping them get to their first meeting.

The 12th Step List member doesn't have to sit home and wait by the phone, but if they do receive a call from a monitor, be able to help out as they can.
