Weekend Big Book Study

Anyone interested in a concise look at understanding and using the 12 Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous in their daily life, should plan to attend the second annual Calgary Weekend Big Book study scheduled for October 8 to 10.

After a successful first Weekend Big Book study in October 2009, which was attended by about 200 Calgary and area AA members, the second annual event will be held at the Rosscarrock Community Centre, 4411 - 10th Ave. SW. (For any who attended the event last year, the Rosscarrock Centre is in the same general area).

"It was a great opportunity to get a much deeper understanding of the Big Book and how to include the 12 Steps in your daily life," says Jason F., one of those who attended the 2009 event. "You can learn as much in one weekend, as otherwise might take months or years of study on your own."

The Weekend Big Book study will again be led by Jim B., assisted by Shane C. and James W. In a page-by-page review of most of the first 164 pages of the Big Book, the focus of the study is, as stated on Page xiii of the First Edition, "To show other alcoholics precisely how we have recovered".

Participants are asked to bring a Big Book, along with pen and paper. The event gets started Friday at 5 p.m. with registration, and resumes Saturday and Sunday at 8 a.m. The \$35 registration fee, which covers the cost of hall rental and meals, includes continental breakfast and lunch Saturday and Sunday, as well as dinner Saturday night. Copies of the Big Book and hi-liters will also be available at the session.
